RE: ARODILEKA OMOSEIBE

Thanks for your letter of the 30th August, 2005. Hospital records show that the corpse of one **Arodileka Omosibe** (presumably the same as **AROLIKA IROWARINU**) was brought to the government mortuary, in State Specialist Hospital, Akure on the 28th of May 1998 at about 10.00 HOURS by the men of the Nigeria Police force.

Post mortem examination was conducted by me at the instance of the police on the 25th of June, 1998 at about 12.40 HOURS. The body was identified to me by the police. It was 1.8 metres long and 90 kg in weight. The late man was a Negro of ilaje extraction. Charms were tied round the waist and the upper aspect of the left arm. The age was estimated to be about forty years.

There were three bullet wounds in the left hemithorax close to the arm-pit.


It was concluded that the man had died of **gun shot wounds** in the left hemithorax. The weapon of assault was most likely a smooth-bore short gun and the range of shooting was about 10 metres.

The actual autopsy report was given to an officer of the Criminal Investigations Department (CID) Police Constable No. 151048 **Pius Laibi** on the 25th June, 1998. The body was subsequently taken away for burial by the relations on the 24th August, 1998.

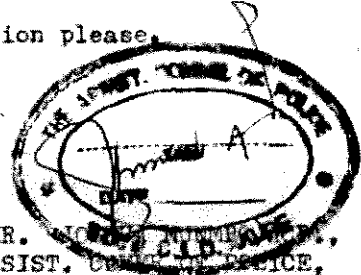
